1. Tray Preparation and Selection Select a trapezoidal cable tray that matches the cable load and volume. Tray widths typically range from 100 to 600 mm, with side heights from 35 to 110 mm. Ensure the tray material and corrosion protection are suitable for the installation environment, whether indoors or outdoors, and that the tray can handle the expected mechanical load . 2. Cable Placement and Spacing Lay cables in an organized manner to prevent overlapping and excessive bending. Maintain the minimum bend radius for each cable type, and avoid sharp turns that could damage insulation. Cables should be fixed at regular intervals along the tray to prevent sagging and ensure mechanical stability. A common guideline is to secure cables every 300-600 mm, depending on cable type and weight . 3. Securing Cables Use appropriate clamps, cable ties, or edge protection strips to secure cables. For trapezoidal trays, clamps should be attached to the tray edges or rails, ensuring screws or fasteners do not damage the cable insulation. When using screw-on connectors, always pass screws from the inner side of the tray and secure with nuts on the outer side to avoid contact with cables . 4. Connector and Joint Considerations When connecting tray sections, use straight or angle connectors as required. For wider trays (≥ 400 mm), a joint plate is recommended to prevent transverse bendin...
