This prevents tangling, maintains bend radius, and allows easy access for maintenance or network expansion . **Distribution and Routing:** They act as distribution points, enabling fibers to be routed to multiple endpoints. Branched or multi-port FTBs allow splitting and rerouting of fibers to different floors, rooms, or subscriber units in FTTH networks . **Storage:** Extra fiber length from incoming cables or pigtails can be coiled and stored inside the box, maintaining proper bend radius and preventing damage .
