

Gabon construction site electrical distribution box configuration



Article Overview

A construction site distribution box in Gabon typically uses a three-phase low-voltage system (240/415 V) with MCBs, RCDs, neutral and earth bars, surge protection, and proper cable management according to IEC standards and local SEEG guidelines.

Electrical Supply Context in Gabon

Construction sites in Gabon are supplied from low-voltage distribution networks fed by local substations, with typical voltages of 240/415 V AC for three-phase systems. The electricity originates from hydraulic ($\approx 40\%$) and thermal sources, and is distributed via medium-voltage lines (5.5 kV, 20 kV, 30 kV) before stepping down to low voltage for site use. Understanding the local supply is crucial for selecting the correct distribution box and protective devices.

Distribution Box Components

A standard construction site distribution box should include the following:

- Incoming Main Switch/Isolator: Allows complete disconnection of the site supply for safety.
- Phase Busbars: Distribute the three-phase supply to outgoing circuits.
- Neutral Bar: Collects all neutral connections from outgoing circuits.
- Earth Bar (PE): Ensures proper grounding of all metallic parts and equipment.
- MCBs (Miniature Circuit Breakers): Protect individual circuits from overcurrent....
