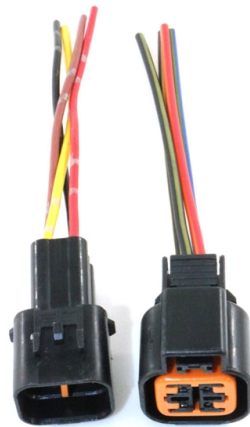


Galvanized flat iron is laid inside the cable tray

The corrosion resistance depends on the thickness of the zinc coating and the environment; thicker coatings offer longer-lasting protection, especially in humid or industrial settings.
