Purpose and Suitability

Galvanized flat iron is often used inside cable trays to support cables, maintain spacing, or provide additional mechanical strength. The flat iron should be compatible with the tray material to avoid galvanic corrosion, which is generally not a concern when both are galvanized steel.

Corrosion Protection

Galvanization provides a protective zinc layer that slows corrosion by forming a stable oxide or zinc carbonate layer over time. This sacrificial protection ensures that even if the surface is scratched, the underlying steel remains protected. The corrosion resistance depends on the thickness of the zinc coating and the environment; thicker coatings offer longer-lasting protection, especially in humid or industrial settings.
