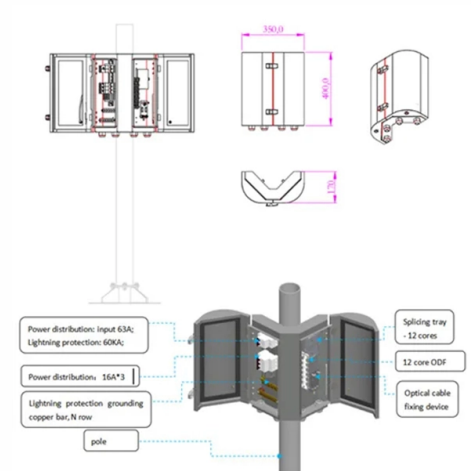


Grid construction of bridges

Bridge-grid is a type of steel grid decking used in bridge construction. It consists of a series of welded steel bars arranged in a grid pattern, typically used either as a stay-in-place form or as the final riding surface. nstruction of steel bridges.
