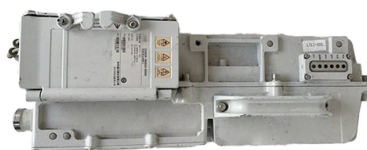


Grounded Distribution Box Connection Method



Article Overview

To safely ground a distribution box, connect the grounding wire from the power source to the PE bar, bond all metallic components, and ensure the ground resistance is below 25 ohms.

Step-by-Step Connection

- **Locate the Grounding Point** Open the distribution box and identify the grounding bar or PE (Protective Earth) terminal, usually marked with a PE symbol or yellow-green color coding. This is the main connection point for all grounding wires inside the box .
- **Connect the Power Ground Wire** Use a yellow-green insulated copper wire with a cross-sectional area meeting local standards (e.g., 6 mm² internationally or 10 AWG in the US). Strip the wire end, insert it into the PE bar terminal, and tighten the screw securely to ensure a firm connection .
- **Ground Electrical Components** Any metallic components inside the box, such as mounting plates, breakers, or controllers, should be connected to the PE bar using copper wires. This ensures all parts are bonded and reduces the risk of electric shock .
- **Connect to External Grounding Electrode** Attach a wire from the PE bar or mounting plate to a grounding rod driven into the earth. This rod can be copper-bonded or galvanized steel, depending on local regulations. The grounding electrode provides a path for fault currents to safely dissipate into the ground .
- **Verify Ground Resistance** Test the resistance between the distribution box and the grounding electrode. It should be less than 25 ohms for effective grounding. If resist...
