

Grounding connection on the door of the distribution box



Article Overview

The metal door of a distribution box must be grounded to the enclosure using a flexible conductor to ensure safety and code compliance.

Why Ground the Door

Even if the distribution box body is already grounded, the door itself can accumulate static charge or become live if an internal fault occurs. NEC 250.148 mandates that all metallic parts of electrical enclosures, including doors, must be bonded to ground to prevent electric shock hazards and ensure personnel safety during maintenance or cleaning .

Recommended Grounding Method

- **Connection Points:** Use pre-fabricated grounding terminals or dedicated bolts on the inside of the door panel and the enclosure frame. These points are often marked with grounding symbols for easy identification .
- **Flexible Conductor:** Connect the door to the enclosure using a braided copper tape or flexible copper wire. This accommodates door movement and maintains a reliable electrical path .
- **Anti-Loosening Hardware:** Use serrated or lock washers to pierce oxide layers and prevent loosening over time, ensuring consistent contact .
- **Surface Preparation:** Remove coatings or oxide layers at the contact points and apply a small amount of conductive grease to reduce contact resistance and prevent corrosion, especially in stainless steel enclosures
