

Grounding wire enters the distribution box

Proper grounding of a distribution box ensures electrical safety by providing a low-resistance path for fault currents and protecting both equipment and personnel.

Key Steps for Grounding

1. Identify the Grounding Points: Open the distribution box and locate the grounding bar (PE bar) or the position marked with a PE symbol. This is the main connection point for all grounding wires in the box .
2. Connect the Power Ground Wire: Use a copper core wire with a yellow-green insulation, ensuring the cross-sectional area meets local standards (e.g., 10 AWG in the US or 6 mm² elsewhere). Strip the wire, insert it into the PE bar terminal, and tighten the screw securely to ensure a firm connection .
3. Ground the Metal Enclosure: The metal housing of the distribution box should be connected to the PE bus using a box grounding bolt or threaded stud. This can be done with a copper wire or a braided soft wire to maintain electrical continuity .
4. Ground Internal Components: Any electrical components inside the box that require grounding should also be connected to the PE bus using copper wires. This ensures all parts of the system are at the same potential and reduces the risk of electrical shock or equipment damage .
5. Connect to the Central Grounding System: The PE bus or mounting plate should be connected to the factory or building central grounding point. The total ground resistance between all system parts should be less than 0.1 ohm for industrial applications .
