

Handling of optical fiber cable hanging points



Article Overview

Proper handling of optical fiber cable hanging points involves using correct clamps, respecting bend radius, securing cables at regular intervals, and following safety protocols to prevent damage and maintain signal integrity.

Key Guidelines for Hanging Points

1. Use Appropriate Clamps and Supports Fiber optic cables must be fixed at regular intervals to avoid stress and sagging. Typically, cables should be secured every 1 meter (3 feet) using clamps that match the cable's outer diameter . For aerial installations, All-Dielectric Self-Supporting (ADSS) cables can be attached to poles or towers without metallic support, allowing safe proximity to power lines . Clamps should prevent crushing or kinking of the cable while holding it firmly in place.
2. Respect Minimum Bend Radius Cables must not be bent more sharply than the minimum bend radius, which is generally 20 times the cable's outer diameter during installation . Exceeding this radius can damage the fiber inside, causing signal loss or permanent failure.
3. Proper Slack Management Slack coils should be positioned near splice closures or entry points, with at least 4 inches of central tube exposed inside the closure . This ensures that the cable can accommodate thermal expansion, wind sway, or minor adjustments without stressing the fiber.
4. Safe Hoisting and Handling When lifting cables to hanging points, use a pulling sock or spreader beam to avoid damaging the cable or connectors . Ensure the cable does not contact sharp edges, and avoid excessive pulling force. Drums should be kept upright during unwinding to prevent twisting or tangling .
