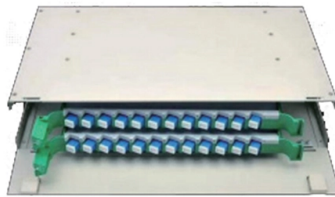


Home electrical distribution box does not have a circuit breaker

A home electrical panel may not have a main breaker if it is a split-bus panel, a main lug only (MLO) panel, or a subpanel, with the main disconnect located elsewhere.

Why Your Panel Might Lack a Main Breaker

- **Split-Bus Panel:** Common in homes built between the 1950s and 1970s, split-bus panels do not have a single main breaker. Instead, the top section contains multiple large breakers (up to six) that act as service disconnects. To shut off all power, each of these breakers must be turned off manually. This design follows the “six-handle rule” from older electrical codes and was considered safe at the time .
- **Main Lug Only (MLO) Panel:** An MLO panel has connection points (lugs) for incoming wires but no built-in main breaker. It relies on a breaker located upstream in another panel or a separate disconnect switch to provide overcurrent protection and serve as the main shutoff .
- **Subpanel:** If your panel is a subpanel, it receives power from a main panel elsewhere in the home. Subpanels do not require a main breaker because the main panel's breaker protects them. The main disconnect may be located near the electric meter or in a primary service panel elsewhere in the house .

Safety and Compliance Considerations

Even if your panel lacks a main breaker, all electrical services must have a way to shut off power. Panels without a main breaker are not inherently unsafe, but they may require multiple steps to disconnect power in an emergency. Modern electrical...
