Article Overview

A home electrical distribution box can be installed in a hallway if it meets NEC clearance, accessibility, and safety requirements.

Location and Accessibility

The National Electrical Code (NEC) requires that electrical panels be installed in readily accessible areas. Hallways are acceptable as long as the panel is not obstructed by furniture, doors, or appliances, and occupants can reach it easily in case of an emergency . The panel should not be placed in bathrooms, clothes closets, or areas with excessive moisture or flammable materials .

Clearance and Mounting Height

- Front clearance: At least 36 inches (3 feet) deep in front of the panel .
- Side clearance: Minimum 30 inches wide .
- Height: The highest breaker should be no more than 6 feet 7 inches (2 meters) from the floor, and the bottom of the panel should be at least 4 feet off the ground for proper accessibility .
- Door operation: The panel door must open to a full 90 degrees .

Safety Considerations

- Install the panel in a dry, ventilated area to prevent corrosion or overheating
