Fiber optic cold connectors, also known as mechanical splices or fast connectors, provide a quick, field-installable method to join optical fibers without fusion splicing.

Overview

Fiber optic cold connectors are mechanical splices that align and join two optical fibers using a pre-installed fiber stub and index-matching gel or mechanical clamping, rather than heat fusion . They are widely used in FTTH (Fiber to the Home) deployments, emergency repairs, and small-scale installations where rapid connection is required .

Advantages

- Cost-effective: No expensive fusion splicing equipment is needed, reducing installation costs .
- Quick installation: Connections can be completed in seconds to minutes, much faster than fusion splicing .
- Field flexibility: Can be installed in remote or hard-to-access locations without power .
- Reusable: Some connectors can be re-terminated by trained technicians .
- Low back reflection: SC/APC cold connectors provide return loss $\geq 60\text{dB}$, suitable for PON and CATV networks .
