

How are optical cables classified



Article Overview

Optical cables are classified based on mode of propagation, core size, material, construction, and application, with single-mode and multimode fibers being the primary categories.

Classification by Mode of Propagation

Optical fibers are primarily classified into single-mode and multimode fibers. Single-mode fibers have a small core (typically less than 9 microns) and allow only one light path, making them suitable for long-distance, high-speed transmission. Multimode fibers have a larger core (commonly 50, 62.5, or 100 microns) and support multiple light paths, which is ideal for shorter distances due to higher signal dispersion and attenuation .

Classification by Core Material

Optical cables can be made from glass (silica) or plastic (polymethylmethacrylate). Glass fibers are used for high-performance, long-distance communication, while plastic fibers are typically used for short-range applications like consumer electronics .

Classification by Refractive Index Profile

- Step-index fibers: The core has a uniform refractive index, and light travels in stra...
