

How high does fiber optic cable need to be for routers

Fiber optic cables do not require a specific height for routers, but proper mounting and accessibility are key for performance and safety.

Key Considerations for Fiber Cable Installation

ONT Placement: The Optical Network Terminal (ONT) is the device that converts fiber optic signals into electrical signals for your router. It is typically mounted on a wall near where the fiber enters your home or building. The ONT should be installed at a convenient height for access, usually between 3 to 6 feet from the floor, to allow easy connection, maintenance, and monitoring . **Router Connection:** The router connects to the ONT via a high-quality Ethernet cable (Cat 6 or Cat 6a recommended). The router itself should be placed in a central location for optimal Wi-Fi coverage, not necessarily at a specific height, but elevated placement (e.g., on a shelf or table) can reduce interference and improve signal distribution . **Cable Handling:** Fiber optic cables are delicate and should not be bent sharply or crushed. Ensure the cable runs are smooth, avoiding tight corners or kinks. If the cable is routed along walls or ceilings, use proper clips or conduits to secure it safely. The height should prevent accidental damage from foot traffic or furniture movement . **Indoor vs. Outdoor Considerations:** For indoor installations, the cable can be mounted along walls or ceilings at a height that keeps it out of reach of children or pets. For outdoor installations, follow local building codes and utility guidelines to maintain clearance from the ground, typically several feet above walkways or driveways, to prevent physical damage . **Future Accessibility:** Positioning the ONT and router at a reasona...
