

How is fiber optic cable calculated

Calculating fiber optic cable involves determining the total cable length required and estimating the total signal loss along the link, including cable attenuation, connector loss, and splice loss.

Calculating Total Cable Length

- Measure the Route: Break the pathway into segments such as tray runs, conduit sections, risers, and underground ducts. Measure each segment accurately, including vertical drops and cabinet entry paths .
- Multiply by Quantity: If a segment is repeated, multiply its length by the number of occurrences.
- Add Routing Slack: Include extra length to accommodate bends, alignment changes, and future re-terminations. Typical slack ranges from 3-10% depending on complexity .
- Include Terminations and Splices: Add lengths for service loops, pull points, and splices to ensure proper handling and maintenance .
- Apply Waste Factor: Account for trimming, damaged ends, or handling losses. This ensures the ordered cable length is sufficient for installation .
- Calculate Reel Count: Divide the total length by the reel size and round up to determine the number of reels needed .

Calculating Total Link Loss (Attenuation)

The total signal loss in a fiber optic link can be estimated using the formula: Total Link Loss (dB) = Cable Attenuation + Connector Loss + Splice Loss...
