

# How many connectors should a fiber optic patch cord have to work properly



## Article Overview

A standard fiber optic patch cord has two connectors, one at each end, with simplex cords having one connector per fiber and duplex cords having two connectors per fiber.

### Standard Configuration

Fiber optic patch cords are designed to connect two devices, such as switches, transceivers, or patch panels, and therefore always have connectors at both ends to enable plug-and-play connectivity . The type and number of connectors depend on the cord's assembly style:

- Simplex Patch Cord: Contains a single fiber with one connector at each end, used for one-way transmission or when only a single fiber is needed .
- Duplex Patch Cord: Contains two fibers joined together, each with a connector at both ends, effectively two connectors per end, often used for bidirectional communication . Duplex cords are sometimes referred to as "zip cords" because the two fibers can be separated or zipped together.
