

# How many fiber optic cables should a network switch use



## Article Overview

A network switch typically requires at least two fiber strands per connection (duplex), but the total number of fibers depends on the number of ports, link speeds, and future expansion plans.

### Basic Requirements

Each duplex connection between switches uses two fiber strands: one for transmitting and one for receiving signals. Most modern switches use SFP or SFP+ transceivers, which are designed for duplex LC connections, and these modules dictate the fiber type (single-mode for long distances, multimode for shorter runs) and strand count per link .

### Planning for Multiple Connections

- **Number of Ports:** Count the active ports on the switch that will use fiber. Each port requires a duplex connection, so multiply the number of fiber ports by two to determine the minimum fiber strands needed .
- **Future Growth:** Add 10-25% spare fibers for testing, repairs, and future expansion. For example, if a switch requires 60 fibers for current connections, provisioning 72 fibers ( $60 \times 1.2$ ) is recommended .
- **High-Speed Links:** For 10G, 25G, 40G, or 100G connections using parallel optics, multiple fibers may be required per link (e.g., 8 or 16 fibers for 100G using parallel optics), ....
