

How many megabits of bandwidth does a fiber optic patch cord support

A fiber optic patch cord can support from 1 Gbps up to 400 Gbps or more, depending on the fiber type, mode, and network equipment used.

Bandwidth by Fiber Type

Single-mode fiber (OS1/OS2) is designed for long-distance transmission and can support extremely high data rates, from 10 Gbps to 400 Gbps and beyond, over distances ranging from several kilometers up to 80 km or more, depending on the transceiver and wavelength. Multimode fiber (OM1, OM2, OM3, OM4, OM5) is optimized for shorter distances. For example:

- OM3/OM4 fibers are commonly used in data centers and can support 10 Gbps, 40 Gbps, 100 Gbps, and even higher speeds over distances of 100–150 meters for 10G and shorter for 100G.
- OM1/OM2 fibers are limited to lower speeds, typically 1 Gbps to 10 Gbps, over shorter distances.

Factors Affecting Supported Bandwidth

- Fiber Mode and Core Size: Single-mode fibers have a small core ($\approx 9 \mu\text{m}$) allowing a single light path, which reduces signal loss and supports higher speeds over long distances. Multimode fibers have larger cores ($50\text{--}62.5 \mu\text{m}$) and multiple light paths, which limits distance and maximum speed.
