The number of optical ports on a switch varies by model, ranging from a few SFP/SFP+ ports to dozens of high-speed QSFP ports, depending on the switch type and intended deployment.

Optical ports on switches are designed for fiber connections and are commonly implemented as SFP (1G), SFP+ (10G), SFP28 (25G), QSFP+ (40G), and QSFP28 (100G) interfaces . These ports allow high-speed, long-distance data transmission and are often used for uplinks, aggregation, or core network connections . Unlike copper RJ45 ports, optical ports require compatible transceivers or fiber modules to operate .

- Access and Enterprise Switches: Often include 2–8 SFP/SFP+ ports for uplinks while the majority of ports are RJ45 copper .
- Data Center or Core Switches: Can have 24–48 SFP/SFP+ ports or multiple QSFP/QSFP28 ports for high-density 40G/100G connections .
- All-Optical Switches: Every port is optical, supporting speeds from 10G to 100G+, and the total number of ports depends on the chassis size and module configuration .
