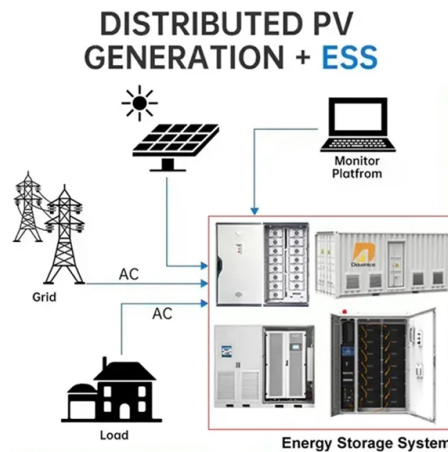

Layer 3 switches (L3 switches) use a network or IP addresses to identify locations on the network. You can assign an IP address to the port, enable routing, and assign routing protocol characteristics to this routed interface.
