

How many routers can be connected to the fiber optic cable

Direct Connection Limitations

Fiber optic internet delivers data to your home via an Optical Network Terminal (ONT), which converts optical signals into electrical signals for your router. Most ONTs provide a single public IP address, meaning only one router can directly manage the internet connection without special ISP provisioning. Connecting multiple routers directly to the ONT can cause IP conflicts and network instability.

Practical Setup for Multiple Routers

To connect more than one router, the common approach is:

- **Primary Router:** Connects directly to the ONT and manages the internet connection, DHCP, and firewall functions.
- **Secondary Router(s):** Connect to the primary router via Ethernet or configured in Access Point mode to extend coverage or create separate network segments. Each secondary router should have a static IP within the same subnet to avoid conflicts. This setup allows multiple routers to operate harmoniously, providing broader Wi-Fi coverage and network segmentation without overloading the ONT....
