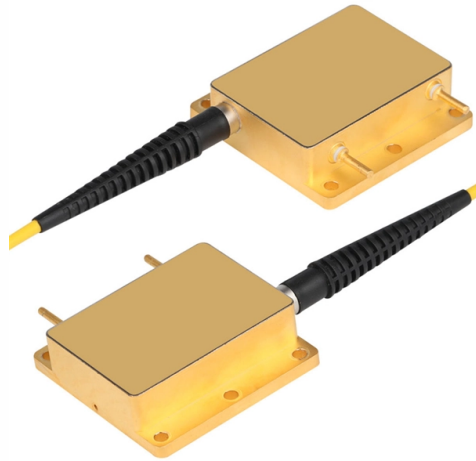


How much space is needed to install an electrical distribution box



Article Overview

A distribution box should be installed at a height of 1–1.8 meters with sufficient clearance around it for ventilation, maintenance, and safe operation.

Height and Accessibility

The recommended installation height for residential and commercial distribution boxes is typically between 1 meter and 1.8 meters from the floor, with 1.3 meters suggested for elderly or handicapped users for easier access (). In industrial settings, the height may be adjusted depending on equipment layout, but the bottom edge is generally 1.5–1.8 meters above the ground to facilitate inspection and operation ().

Clearance and Working Space

Adequate space around the distribution box is essential for safety and maintenance. Standards such as IEC 61439 and BS 7671 require that panels be readily accessible, with sufficient clearance for personnel to operate, inspect, and maintain the equipment (). Typical industrial panel dimensions may include a maximum width of 1.5 meters, height of 1.2 meters, and depth of 0.5 meters, with additional space around the box for airflow and safe access ().
