Importance of Sealing

Sealing a distribution box is critical for both safety and longevity. Methods and Materials

- Gaskets and Cable Glands: Use gaskets and cable glands that match the required IP or NEMA rating to block dust and water ingress .
- Sealants: Non-hardening electrical putty or duct seal compound can seal wire entries inside the box, remaining flexible for future adjustments . Fire-rated caulks or minimal-expansion foams can seal gaps between the box and surrounding walls, providing both air and fire protection .
- Material Selection: High-quality insulating materials like SMC composites, epoxy resin, and weather-resistant silicone rubber improve long-term insulation and reduce maintenance costs
