

# How to Choose a 10 Gigabit Optical Cable

- Calculate the link power budget, which accounts for transmitter power, receiver sensitivity, and total channel loss including cable attenuation, splice losses, and connector losses .
- For short-range applications, MMF is sufficient, but for distances exceeding a few hundred meters, SMF is recommended to maintain signal integrity .

### Installation Environment

- Indoor cables often use PVC or LSZH jackets. LSZH is preferred in confined spaces for fire safety and low smoke emission .
- Outdoor cables require PE jackets for UV resistance, moisture protection, and tem...
