- CE and FCC Marks: Indicate compliance with European and U.S. safety, electromagnetic, and environmental standards.
- MSA Compliance: Ensures modules are interoperable with equipment from different vendors, following Multi-Source Agreement standards . These certifications validate that modules are safe, durable, and compatible with network equipment, reducing downtime and repair costs .
