

How to check fiber optic data on a router

You can check fiber optic data on a router by accessing the router's admin panel, inspecting SFP/ONT module status, and using diagnostic tools like optical power meters or OTDRs.

Router-Based Checks

- **Access the Admin Panel:** Open a web browser and enter your router's IP address (commonly 192.168.1.1). Log in with your credentials provided by your ISP or set during setup .
- **Check WAN/ONT Status:** Look for the WAN or fiber interface section. Routers connected via an ONT (Optical Network Terminal) often display link status, connection speed, and signal quality .
- **SFP Module Diagnostics:** If your router has an SFP port, you can check the transceiver details. On some enterprise routers, commands like `show interfaces transceiver detail` provide information about optical power, wavelength, and module health . Note that non-DOM SFPs may not report diagnostic data.
- **Indicator Lights:** Many routers and ONTs have LEDs indicating link status. A solid light usually means a stable connection, while blinking or off lights may indicate signal loss or misconfiguration .

Physical and Signal Checks

- **Inspect Fiber Cables:** Ensure cables are properly connected, free of bends, and connectors are clean. Dirty or damaged connectors are a common cause of signal degradation .
- **Use Fiber Testing Tools:** Optical power meters measure signal strength, while OTDRs (Optical Time-Domain Reflectometers) can locate faults or breaks along the...
