

How to cold-splice fiber optic cables and pigtails

Cold-splicing fiber optic cables involves aligning and securing bare fiber ends in a mechanical splice without heat, creating a low-loss, reliable connection.

What is Cold Splicing?

Cold splicing, also called mechanical splicing, is a method of joining two optical fibers by precisely aligning their cores inside a splice device, without using a fusion splicer or heat. It is faster and more convenient for field installations, especially in FTTH (fiber-to-the-home) deployments, and is ideal when you need a quick, low-cost connection .

Tools and Materials Needed

To perform a cold splice, you will need:

- Cold splice connectors or mechanical splicers with v-groove alignment
- Fiber optic pigtails (pre-terminated on one end)
- Fiber stripper to remove the protective coating
- Cleaver to cut the fiber to a precise length
- Alcohol wipes for cleaning the bare fiber
- Protective sleeves or snap rings to secure the splice
- Optional: magnification or inspection scope to verify alignment...
