

How to conceal a power distribution box

You can hide a power distribution box using decorative covers, hinged artwork, mirrors, or shallow cabinets while ensuring safety and code compliance.

Safety and Code Considerations

Before concealing a breaker or electrical panel, it is crucial to maintain clear working space for emergency access. The National Electrical Code (NEC) requires a minimum 36-inch depth in front of the panel, 30-inch width (or full panel width), and 6 feet 6 inches vertical clearance. Any cover must be non-permanent and instantly removable without tools to allow rapid access for maintenance or emergencies . Avoid heavy or obstructive materials that could hinder access or pose a hazard.

Creative Concealment Ideas

- **Hinged Artwork or Mirrors:** Mount a lightweight frame or mirror on butt hinges so it swings open like a door. Magnetic catches or small latches keep it flush against the wall but allow tool-less access .
- **Wall Hangings or Tapestries:** Large decorative fabrics or wall hangings can cover the panel and be easily moved aside when needed .
- **Curtains or Fabric Panels:** A curtain matching the room's décor provides a quick, elegant solution that is easy to open for access .
- **Shallow Cabinets or Folding Screens:** Build a shallow cabinet or use a lightweight folding screen to hide the box while keeping it accessible .
- **Pegboards or Bulletin Boards:** These can camouflage the panel while providing functional storage for tools, notes, or small decorative items .
- **Artistic or Thematic Covers:** Disguise the box as a painting, chalkboard, or even a...
