

How to connect a 144-core fiber optic cable

Connecting a 144-core fiber optic cable requires careful preparation, ribbon splicing, proper termination, and secure cable management to ensure optimal network performance.

Preparation and Safety

Before starting, ensure you have safety glasses, gloves, and proper tools such as a fiber cleaver, fusion splicer, and cable connector kits . Never look directly into the fiber ends, as laser light may be present and can cause serious eye damage . Conduct a site survey to plan cable routing, leaving extra conduit space for future expansion, and verify compliance with local building codes .

Cable Entry and Organization

- Mount the fiber optic cabinet securely using base holes.
- Strip the outer jacket of the 144-core cable carefully, exposing the fiber ribbons without damaging them.
- Fix the cable using cable clamps and a strengthening member kit to prevent tension on the fibers .
- Place the stripped fibers into transparent tubes and organize them into splice tray units for easy access and management .
