

How to connect a dual-core LC optical cable for telecommunications

To connect a dual-core LC optical cable, ensure proper cleaning, correct Tx/Rx polarity, and secure insertion into the LC duplex adapter or transceiver.

Understanding Dual-Core LC Connectors

A dual-core LC (duplex LC) connector houses two fibers side-by-side: one for transmitting (Tx) and one for receiving (Rx) optical signals. This configuration enables full-duplex communication, which is standard in Ethernet and telecom links. The connector uses a 1.25 mm ceramic ferrule for precise fiber alignment and comes in single-mode (SMF) or multimode (MMF) versions. Correct polarity is critical: connecting Tx to Tx or Rx to Rx will prevent signal transmission .

Preparation Steps

- **Work Area:** Ensure a clean, dust-free environment to prevent contamination .
- **Tools and Materials:** Gather LC fiber connectors, fiber strippers or cutters, cleaning tools (alcohol wipes, fiber cleaning pen), and testing equipment (power meter, OTDR if available), .
- **Cable Preparation:** For new cables, carefully strip the outer jacket without damaging the inner fibers. For pre-terminated cables, keep dust caps in place until connection .
- **Cleaning:** Clean the fiber end faces using approved methods (dry or wet-to-dry) and inspect with a fiber scope to ensure no dust or scratches .
