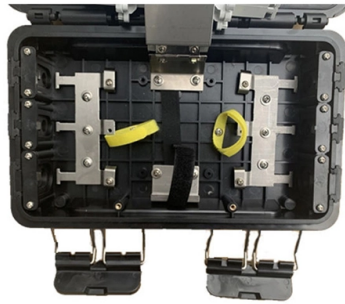


How to connect a single-mode fiber optic terminal block

Connecting a single-mode fiber optic terminal block involves preparing the fiber, splicing it to pigtails, and securing it in the terminal box to ensure low loss and minimal back reflection.

Step 1: Prepare the Fiber

Begin by organizing your workspace and tools, including fiber strippers, cleaver, alcohol, lint-free wipes, and the fiber termination kit . Carefully strip the fiber buffer in sections to avoid breakage, then clean the exposed fiber with isopropyl alcohol to remove any coating residue . Avoid touching the fiber after cleaning to prevent contamination.

Step 2: Choose the Connector Type

Single-mode fibers typically use LC or SC connectors. Ensure you match the polish type: APC (angled, green) to APC and UPC (flat, blue) to UPC . Mixing polish types or multimode with single-mode fibers will result in poor signal transmission.

Step 3: Splice Fiber to Pigtails

Most single-mode terminations are done by fusion splicing the fiber to pre-terminated pigtails . Insert the fiber and pigtail into the fusion splicer, align them, and perform the splice . After splicing, store any excess fiber in the terminal box's splice tray to p...
