

# How to connect a two-core fiber optic distribution box



## Article Overview

Use patch cords and adapters to connect the two fiber cores safely and efficiently, avoiding direct splicing inside the distribution box.

### Step 1: Prepare the Distribution Box

- Mount the box securely on a wall or rack according to the manufacturer's instructions, ensuring proper alignment and accessibility for future maintenance .
- Check the internal components, including splice trays, adapter panels, and cable management rods, to ensure they are ready for fiber routing .

### Step 2: Introduce Fiber Cables

- Feed the incoming and outgoing fiber cables through the designated cable entry points using grommets or protective sleeves to prevent damage .
- Ensure the fiber cables have enough slack to allow the front panel or drawer of the distribution box to be fully extended without tension .

### Step 3: Terminate and Clean Fibers

- Strip the fiber jackets carefully and clean the fiber ends using lint-free wipes and alcohol .
- Inspect the connectors to ensure they are free of dust, oil, or damage. Avoid touching the ferrule tips with bare hands ....
