

How to connect an active optical splitter



Article Overview

To connect an active optical splitter, first power the splitter, then connect the optical source to the input, and finally link the outputs to your devices using optical cables.

Step-by-Step Connection

- **Power the Splitter** Active optical splitters require external power to amplify and maintain signal strength. Plug the included DC adapter into the splitter and connect it to an AC outlet. Ensure the voltage matches the splitter's specifications to avoid damage .
- **Connect the Optical Source** Using a compatible optical cable (TOSLINK or fiber), connect the source device's optical output (e.g., Blu-ray player, TV, or game console) to the splitter's input port. Make sure the cable is fully seated; you should see a red light if using TOSLINK .
- **Connect the Outputs** Use optical cables to connect each output port of the splitter to your receiving devices, such as soundbars, receivers, or DACs. Active splitters can maintain strong signals across multiple outputs, even over longer distances .
- **Verify Audio or Signal Settings** Ensure the source device is set to output a supported format (PCM 2.0, Dolby Digital, or DTS 5.1 for audio splitters). For fiber networks, confirm the network devices are compatible with the splitter's split ratio and signal type .
- **Test the Signal** Check that each connected device is receiving the signal correctly. For audio, listen for proper output; for fiber networks, use an optical power meter to measure signal strength at each output port. If signals are weak, check cable connections or consider using a signal amplifier .
