Before connecting, clean every connector end face, even if it appears clean, using a fiber optic cleaner suitable for the connector type. Dust or dirt can cause significant signal loss. Always inspect connectors for scratches or contamination before mating.

Handling and Routing

Handle patch cords carefully to avoid lateral stress. Follow minimum bend-radius guidelines to prevent signal loss and cable damage.
