

How to connect composite optical cables to a terminal box



Article Overview

To connect a composite optical cable to a terminal box, you need to splice the optical fibers, connect the copper wires, and secure both inside the terminal box following proper procedures.

Step-by-Step Guide

1. Prepare the Cable and Terminal Box

- Route the composite optical cable through the entry point of the terminal box.
- Remove the outer jacket of the cable to expose the optical fibers and copper wires.

The copper wires should be stripped about 5-8 mm from the jacket . 2. Connect the Copper Wires

- Use a crimp tube or connector to attach the copper wires to the corresponding terminals inside the box.
- Match the color-coded wires (e.g., red to red, black to black) and secure the crimp tube to prevent copper leakage . 3. Splice the Optical Fibers

- Carefully separate the optical fibers from the composite cable.
- Use a fusion splicer or mechanical splice to join the fibers with LC pigtails or other compatible connectors .

- Coil the spliced fibers neatly inside the terminal box to avoid bending or stress . 4. Connect to Devices

- Connect the LC pigtail from the terminal box to the optical port of the receiving device (e.g., router, media converter, or RU) using a fiber patch cable
