

How to connect optical fibers to an optical cable pulling machine



Article Overview

Fiber optic cables should be connected to a pulling machine using the cable's strength members, proper pulling eyes, and secure grips to prevent damage during installation.

Preparation and Safety

Before connecting the fiber optic cable to the pulling machine, ensure you have safety equipment such as gloves and safety glasses to protect against glass shards, and verify that the installation area is stable and dust-free . Inspect the cable for any damage or kinks, and confirm the route is clear and measured to avoid mid-pull splicing .

Using the Strength Members

Fiber optic cables are designed with internal strength members (typically aramid yarn or Kevlar) that bear the pulling load. Never pull the cable by the outer jacket unless the manufacturer explicitly allows it . Exposing a small portion of the strength member by carefully stripping the jacket allows you to attach the pulling hardware securely.

Attaching Pulling Hardware

- Pulling Eye or Pull Sock: Loop the exposed strength member into a cable pull-eye or mesh pull sock. Double-back and tape or knot the yarn to ensure it is secure
