

How to connect the optical port of the core switch



Article Overview

To connect a switch optical port to the core, insert the correct SFP/SFP+ transceiver into the switch port, then connect the appropriate fiber optic cable, ensuring proper orientation, labeling, and handling.

Step-by-Step Guide

1. Select the Correct Transceiver and Cable

- Determine the type of SFP or SFP+ transceiver compatible with both the switch and the core device (e.g., short wavelength, long wavelength, or extended long wavelength) and the required speed (1G, 10G, 16G) .

- Choose the matching fiber optic cable (single-mode or multi-mode) according to the transceiver specifications .

2. Prepare for Installation

- Wear an ESD wrist strap to prevent electrostatic discharge .
- Ensure the transceiver and cable connectors are clean and free of dust or debris .
- Label both ends of the fiber cable with the device name and port number for easy identification and maintenance .

3. Install the Transceiver

- Hold the SFP/SFP+ module by its sides and align it with the port on the switch .
- Slide the transceiver into the port until it clicks into place. If the module has a handle or bail, secure it according to the manufacturer's instructions .

4. Connect the Fiber Cable

- Align the keyed connector of the fiber cable with the transceiver slot and insert it until the latching mechanism clicks
