

# How to cover the cables outside the cable tray

Cables outside a cable tray can be protected using ventilated or solid covers, secured with clamps, and designed to withstand environmental conditions like wind, rain, and UV exposure.

### Choosing the Right Cover

When covering cables outside a tray, the type of cover depends on the environment and cable requirements. Common options include dome-shaped, flat, peaked, finned, corrugated, ventilated, or solid covers made from metal, composite, or plastic materials. For outdoor installations, ventilated covers are often preferred to allow airflow while still protecting cables from debris, UV light, and moisture. Solid covers can be used but require additional precautions to prevent wind lift or buckling.

### Installation and Securing

Proper installation is critical for safety and durability:

- Clamp the covers securely using heavy-duty wrap-around or bar/strap clamps, especially in windy areas.
- Overlap covers at expansion joints to prevent buckling under snow or ice loads.
- Add stiffeners or flanges to increase rigidity and resist environmental forces.
- Ensure the cover matches the tray profile and support method to maintain stability and allow inspection ....
