

How to deal with the cable trays near the entrance

Ensure cable trays near entrances are safely routed, properly supported, and protected from physical damage while maintaining accessibility and code compliance.

Safety and Accessibility

Cable trays near entrances must remain accessible for maintenance and inspection, and should not obstruct walkways or emergency exits . Maintain at least 12 inches of vertical clearance above the tray to allow safe access and prevent accidental contact with cables . Avoid placing trays in areas where they could be struck by doors, carts, or foot traffic.

Physical Protection

To prevent damage, consider using covers or solid-bottom trays in high-traffic areas . Ladder or ventilated trough trays can be used, but in entrances, solid or covered trays provide extra protection against impact and debris . Metallic trays can also serve as grounding conductors if installed according to NEC requirements .

Routing and Layout

- Shortest and straightest path: Route trays along walls or ceilings to minimize obstruction and simplify maintenance .
- Segregation of cables: Keep high-voltage and low-voltage cables separate to redu...
