

How to determine the location of cable trays

Cable trays are located by planning their route, marking the path, and using proper supports and alignment tools to ensure safe and accessible installation.

Planning the Route

Before physically locating cable trays, plan the route carefully based on the site layout and electrical design. Consider clearance from walls, ceilings, and other equipment, as well as load capacity and cable separation requirements. Mark the intended path on walls, ceilings, or floors to visualize the tray layout and avoid conflicts with other systems .

Marking and Alignment

Use tools like laser levels or chalk lines to trace a straight line where the trays will pass. This ensures the trays are aligned properly and prevents sagging or misalignment during installation . For long runs, a cable tray roller can help lay cables smoothly once the trays are in place .

Choosing Supports

Cable trays can be mounted in different ways depending on the location:
