

How to fix cable trays and angle iron

Cable trays can be securely fixed using angle iron by properly measuring, aligning, and bolting the trays to the angle iron supports while adhering to load and spacing guidelines.

Step-by-Step Guide

1. Select Appropriate Angle Iron and Hardware Choose angle iron with sufficient thickness and strength to support the cable tray load. Ensure all bolts, nuts, and washers are compatible with the tray type and material (galvanized or stainless steel) to prevent corrosion and maintain structural integrity . 2. Overloading or excessive spacing can cause sagging or deflection. 3. Position and Align Angle Iron Supports Mount the angle iron vertically or horizontally depending on the installation (wall, ceiling, or floor). Ensure the angle iron is level and aligned with the intended cable tray path. Use a spirit level and measuring tape to maintain straightness and proper height. 4. Attach Cable Trays to Angle Iron

- Place the cable tray on the angle iron support.
- Use bolts, clamps, or tray-specific brackets to secure the tray to the angle iron. Ensure all fasteners are tightened to prevent vibration or movement .
- For long runs, connect multiple tray sections with joint plates or splice kits to maintain alignment and structural continuity. 5. Check Load and Stability Verify that the tray is not overloaded and that the angle iron supports are not bending or shifti...
