

How to fix the cable tray inside the vertical cable tray

Cables in a vertical cable tray can be securely fixed using binding tape, hooks, ladder or spiral methods, with attention to cable size, weight, and heat dissipation.

Common Fixing Methods

- **Binding Tape Method** Thread binding tape through the cables and attach it to the inner wall of the tray. This method is simple and works well for small to medium cables, but it is not suitable for very large or heavy cables .
- **Hook Method** Install hooks along the inner wall of the tray and hang the cables on them. This method is ideal for large or heavy cables, providing strong support, but requires additional processing to install the hooks .
- **Ladder Method** Arrange cables along a trapezoidal track and secure them with binding tape. This method is suitable for large cables and ensures even distribution along the tray, but the tray must be compatible with ladder-style supports .
- **Spiral Method** Wrap cables along a spiral track and fix them with binding tape. This method is effective for large cables and allows for organized vertical stacking, but requires specialized spiral tracks .

Best Practices

- **Firm Fixation:** Ensure cables are tightly secured to prevent detachment or sliding, which could create safety hazards .
- **Cable Organization:** Keep cables tidy and avoid disorderly arrangements to maintain accessibility and airflow
