

# How to form a circle around the cable trays



## Article Overview

To form a circular layout around cable trays, use gradual bends, maintain proper bend radius, and connect segments carefully to create a smooth curve.

### Step-by-Step Guide

1. Plan the Circular Path Determine the center and radius of the circle you want the cable tray to follow. Ensure there is enough clearance for cables, maintenance, and future expansion. Consider the type of cable tray (wire mesh, solid, or ventilated) and the load it will carry, as this affects bend radius and support spacing .
2. Use Proper Bends and Fittings For wire mesh trays, bends can be made on-site using a bolt cutter to cut and shape the tray, then secure with protective caps to prevent damage . For solid or channel trays, use pre-fabricated curved sections or adjustable elbows to achieve the circular path. Maintain the minimum bend radius recommended for the cables to prevent stress or signal loss .
3. Connect Segments Smoothly Snap or bolt together individual tray segments, ensuring each connection aligns with the circular path. In software modeling (e.g., Revit MEP), you can adjust the bend radius multiplier and convert straight segments into T or cross fittings to form a smooth curve . Check that each segment maintains consistent width and elevation.
4. Support and Secure the Tray Install supports at regular intervals along the curve to prevent sagging. For wire mesh trays, a rung spacing of 6–9 inches (150–230 mm) is recommended for small instrumentation cables . Ensure supports do not interfere with the circular alignment.
5. Verify Clearance and Safety Ensure sufficient clearance from walls, ceilings, and other equipment. Check that the circular layout does not c...
