

How to handle the main optical cable after it reaches the equipment room



Overview

Field crews should use bend radius protectors or large-diameter storage spools when moving cable from the warehouse to the job site. Fiber optic cable, equipment and supplies should be scheduled for delivery to the work site as closely to the time of use as possible to minimize possible damage from other. Fiber optic cables can be easily damaged if they are improperly handled or installed. Improper storage introduces microbends, macrobends, and physical stress that degrade signal integrity and increase. CAUTION: Before starting any cable installation, all personnel must be thoroughly familiar with all applicable Occupational Safety and Health Act (OSHA) regulations, the National Electric Safety Code (NESC), state and local regulations, and company practices and policies. Handle the cable as per guidelines given in STL/AEN/01. Leave your cable boxes in a safe place until your team is ready to use them. Err on the side of caution to avoid potentially damaging situations – like someone rolling a cabinet over it – crashing into it.
