

How to install ASS fiber optic cable on power poles



Article Overview

ADSS fiber optic cables can be safely installed on power poles by following proper planning, hardware selection, tensioning, and safety procedures, ensuring compliance with regulations and long-term reliability.

Planning and Preparation

Before installation, conduct a site survey to map the route, identify existing poles, obstacles, and power lines, and determine splice points and slack storage locations. Obtain permits from local authorities and coordinate with utility companies if sharing poles with power lines. Ensure poles are “made ready” and capable of supporting the cable load without structural modifications .

Cable Selection

Use All-Dielectric Self-Supporting (ADSS) cables, which are non-conductive and designed to withstand high-voltage environments. ADSS cables contain aramid yarn or glass-reinforced plastic for strength, are lightweight, UV-resistant, and flexible, allowing spans up to 1000 meters between poles . Ensure the cable jacket is carbon-black polyethylene for UV protection.
