

How to install terminal blocks in a distribution box

- Cut wires to the appropriate length, leaving enough slack for maintenance but avoiding clutter .
- Strip insulation from the wire ends, typically 6-10 mm depending on the terminal block type .
- For stranded wires, use ferrules to prevent fraying and ensure a secure connection .
