

How to lay large cables on cable trays

Laying large cables in cable trays requires careful planning, proper tray selection, controlled handling, and adherence to spacing and fill rules to ensure safety and system reliability.

Planning and Tray Selection

Before installation, plan the cable route considering clearance, load capacity, and separation from other services. Choose the appropriate tray type based on cable size and environment: ladder trays provide excellent ventilation for heat dissipation, ventilated troughs offer continuous support for medium cables, and solid-bottom trays protect cables from debris or fluids but reduce airflow. Ensure the tray width and depth accommodate the total cable cross-section without exceeding 40% of tray fill capacity.

Support and Mounting

Secure trays using brackets, wall mounts, or suspended supports at regular intervals (typically 1.5–3 meters depending on tray type and load) to prevent sagging. Proper support is critical for large cables to avoid mechanical stress and maintain alignment. For long runs, cable tray rollers can facilitate smooth cable pulling and reduce kinks or insulation damage.
