Ladder trays are ideal for large power cables due to ventilation, while perforated or solid-bottom trays suit lighter or sensitive cables ().

Cable Laying Techniques

- **Organized Placement:** Lay cables neatly along the tray, avoiding excessive bending or twisting. Maintain the minimum bend radius specified by the manufacturer to prevent insulation damage ().
- **Spacing and Segregation:** Use cable ties, straps, or separators to maintain spacing between cables. Avoid overfilling; cable fill should not exceed 40% of tray capacity to ensure heat dissipation and prevent derating of ampacity ().
- **Support and Securing:** Fix cables at regular intervals using clamps or ties. Support spans for trays typically range from 1.5 to 3 meters depending on tray type and load (). Trapeze hangers or cantilever brackets can be used for ceiling or wall-mounted trays ()...
