- Double Sheath ADSS Cable: Designed for spans exceeding 200 meters; provides higher tensile strength and stability for long-distance installations up to 700 meters between towers .
- Mini ADSS-ASU Cable: Compact design for spans within 100 meters and up to 48 cores; used for smaller-scale or facility-specific connections .

Key Hardware Components

- Suspension Clamps: Used for mid-span support; allow the cable to hang freely while minimizing bending stress. Typically made of aluminum alloy or anti-UV polymer with protective inlays .
- Tension Clamps (Dead-End Clamps): Installed at terminal points or where the cable changes direction; rigidly hold the cable and transfer mechanical loads to poles or towers. Often include preformed helical rods and corrosion-resistant fittings .
- Anchor Clamps: Fasten cables vertically along poles or towers; prevent slipping, vibration, or shaking under environmental forces
